

Medicare Commode Qualifications

Prescription

- Patient's Name
- Date of Order
- General Description (e.g., Commode, Commode Chair with fixed arms, Commode Chair with detachable arms, Extra Wide/Heavy Duty Commode Chair)
- Physician's Signature
- Physician Name Printed or NPI

Chart Notes (must support the following)

A **Commode** is covered when the patient is physically incapable of utilizing regular toilet facilities. This would occur in the following situations:

- 1. The patient is confined to a single room, or
- 2. The patient is confined to one level of the home and there is no toilet on that level, or
- 3. The patient is confined to the home, and there are no toilet facilities in the home.

Additional Information

- Extra wide/heavy duty commode meets one of the criteria above and;
 - Patient weighs over 300 lbs.
- Commode with detachable arms meets one of the criteria above and;
 - o It is necessary to facilitate transferring the patient or
 - o Patient's body configuration requires extra width.

If also ordering wheelchair/walker, documentation must clearly explain why patient would still be unable to access the bathroom facility with the use of mobility equipment.
